Welcome to the Forest City Program!

We wanted to reach out to our students and families in the DE Work Experience Forest City Program in this additional newsletter. We are very much looking forward to seeing you next week at school. You may have already received a welcome call from your child's teacher and if you haven't yet, you will hear from them this week.

All Central families will have received the safety protocols contained in the *September Ghost Post Second Edition*, however, we wanted to provide some additional information that specifically relates to the Forest City Program.

Arrival and Access to Building: Students in the Forest City Program will be greeted by educational assistants at the buses and will proceed to the main doors on Waterloo Street for entry to the school. For students in the Forest City Program who take the LTC, the school doors will open at 7:55 am. Please arrive as close to 7:55 am as possible if you take public transportation.

Entrance Protocol: Students will enter the building with their class with support provided by the educational assistant. Educational assistants will support students with this transition from bus to classroom. Students are required to wear masks upon entry to the school.

Lunch Procedures: Students are expected to remain at school during the lunch period to maintain their cohort. Students will eat their lunches in their classrooms or in a designated area with their cohort with supervision provided by the educational assistant. Should you give permission for your student to leave the school at lunch, they will not be permitted back into the school, or on school property until five minutes prior to the start of afternoon classes. Please note that supervision is not provided outside of the school.

SEA Equipment: Students who currently have their SEA equipment at home are asked to please bring their devices to school with them on the first day. As we move forward, SEA equipment will be kept at school each day.
