Orange Shirt Day, Every Child Matters

On September 30, London Central Secondary School, along with all schools in the TVDSB, recognized Orange Shirt Day, Every Child Matters. This important nation-wide initiative honours survivors of Residential Schools and remembers those who did not make it home from Residential Schools. Students and staff at LCSS honoured this day on Tuesday, September 29 for students in Cohort A and on Wednesday, September 30 for students in Cohort B. We wear orange to bring awareness of the harm that the Residential School system did to Indigenous children's identity, self-esteem and well-being, and as a reminder that everyone around us matters.
