## QUAD 4 CREDIT IMPROVEMENT/RESCUE DAYS

As we have done in previous Quadesters, students who make arrangements with their teachers, may spend the last instructional block (120 minutes) of the last day in their course to work on Credit Rescue or Credit Improvement. We will have more specific information about the structure and attendance reporting for these days after we have more clarity from the Government about which learning model we will be in (in-person or remote) for the rest of the school year.

## DECLARATION OF LEARNING REMINDER

This is a gentle reminder that a declaration must be made for each student by **June 1st** indicating whether your child will attend In-Person or Full-Remote Learning for next year. We would like to ask that if parents are ready to make this choice now, that it be entered **as soon as possible**.

Once again, June 1st is the final date, but having this information **prior to the deadline will help us begin planning for September**.

We have been provided **with additional information regarding Full Remote Learning for 2021/22**. There will be a handful of HOST schools next year for Full Remote across TVDSB. Students who are registered at Central and choose Full Remote would attend, virtually, that HOST school. All student supports (Guidance, Student Success, Learning Support Teachers, ESL Support, Administration, etc.) would be from the HOST school & not Central. The HOST school would also provide daily attendance, report cards, awards, etc. Full Remote students from Central would be able to return to Central in 2022/23. Graduating students will be able to attend & participate in Central's graduation/commencement next year with their peers.
